





E-Book Features:

| Content boxes | |
| | Content boxes contain the main text of the chapter. The text may be edited and formatted. If you wish to save your text, simply copy and paste the text into a word processing application, such as Word, and save the document. |
| Text hide/show | |
| | All text has a show/hide button which will allow text to either be visible or not. |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> | Clicking the button once will hide the text |
| <input type="checkbox"/> | Clicking on this button will show the text |
| Format text box | |
| | All text in the content boxes has the ability to be formatted. Simply double click inside a text box for the formatting tool bar. |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/>  | <p>This allows you to highlight text in a range of colours by selecting text and then choosing a colour.</p> <p>Text size and spacing can be changed.</p> <p>Bold, italics or underline can be added to text.</p> <p>Text can be changed from Left Align to Centre, Right or Justified.</p> <p>You can move the Format text box by clicking on it whilst holding down your left mouse button.</p> |
| Speech/Thought bubbles | |
|  | <p>By clicking on the face of a main character a speech bubble can be added. You can change the speech bubble to a thought bubble by clicking on the pointer. Text can then be added to each speech bubble. To hide a speech bubble either click on the face of the character again or use the menu.</p> <p>To format the text in a speech/thought bubble, click on a main character to show a bubble, and then click on the text in the main content box to bring up the Format text box, and then highlight the text in the bubble.</p> |
| Callouts | |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/>  | <p>Callouts can be added, just like speech bubbles to all pictures without characters. Text can be added to these speech bubbles. Formatting can be added by double clicking within the text box.</p> |

| Add your own text | |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/>  | To add your own text simply use the menu and click on “ <i>Add your own text</i> ”. Text boxes have the ability to store text throughout the whole chapter. Text can also be formatted and hidden as with content boxes. |
| Caption boxes | |
| <input checked="" type="checkbox"/> Did you know? <i>The Mousetrap</i> , by Agatha Christie is the world’s longest running play. Since opening in London in 1952, it has been performed more than 17 000 times, to a total audience of more than 9 million people. | Caption boxes appear automatically on the screen. These items hold additional information relating to the chapter. Text can be hidden, edited and formatted. |
| Copy and Paste | |
| | CTRL + C to copy text CTRL + X to cut text CTRL + V to paste text |

Menu:

The menu has been designed so that it is easy to use for both individual computers and for interactive whiteboards, and can be found on the bottom right-hand corner of the screen.

| <i>Menu Button</i> | |
|  | To access the menu click on the “ <i>Menu</i> ” button, then click on the button you require. |
| <i>Show Speech and Thought Bubbles</i> | |
|  | This button allows you to see all of the speech and thought bubbles after you have used one of them. |
| <i>Add your own text</i> | |
|  | This button allows you to add your own text box. See above “ <i>Format Text box</i> ”. |
| <i>Revert to Original Story</i> | |
|  | This button allows you to revert to the original text shown in the chapter. |
| <i>Print Screen</i> | |
|  | This button allows you to print the current page that you are on. |
| <i>Independent Activities</i> | |
|  | This teaching resource has suggestions for activities that the students can do independently. |
| <i>Word and Sentence Level</i> | |
|  | This teaching resource has word and sentence activities. |
